Dear Parents

I would like to invite your children to join us this year for Summer Day Camp. The dates are **June 12-16, 2017** and the camp will run from **9am - 4pm daily**. The students must have **completed kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade**. We request a donation of **\$25** per child for food and supplies. If you are able to give another \$25 to help cover a scholarship it would be appreciated. Please know we do not want any child to be unable to attend camp; therefore, we use the scholarship money to help others experience camp. Please contact me if you need assistance.

Day camp is intended to offer a safe place for a quality Christian experience to your child by providing a Christ-centered day program in our community. By partnering with Lutheran Outdoor Ministries of Ohio, we hope your child will become enthusiastic about camping; however, our bigger concern is to get them excited about the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

- To register, please complete the attached Day Camp Registration, Health and Permission Form and return it to our office **before June 5** with your check or cash. Please make checks out to Christ the King and indicate "Day Camp" in the memo.
- You or the person designated must check in at the desk each day of camp to drop off and/or pick up your child. Please do not drop off your child in the parking lot without checking them in at the desk.
- Please dress your child in clothes that may become wet and dirty. They must have closed toed shoes that are appropriate for outdoor hiking and games.
- If your child is on medication that must be taken during the day, please bring it in the original container with full instructions and give it to the person at the registration desk.
- We will provide your child with snacks and lunch. If your child has any food allergies, make sure they are indicated on the registration form.
- If you are unable to pick your child up by 4:15pm, please contact the church office immediately. We will ensure your child is supervised until you are able to arrive.
- As a service project, we will be collecting money to purchase a water well for a 3<sup>rd</sup> World countries through the ELCA Good Gifts, God's Global Barnyard. Have your camper bring in coins to help.
