### SPECIAL INDOOR WORSHIP SERVICE JULY 11TH

On Sunday, July 11th, at 9:00 AM, CtK will hold its weekly worship service in the sanctuary in lieu of the outdoor service. This will be a celebration of loosening of pandemic restrictions after almost 16 months. The new CtK CARE team will be consecrated at the service, as will communion sets for home visits. A reception is planned for after the service.



At press time, indoor worship was planned for only this single week in July. Dates for additional indoor services will be announced.

### CTK FOLLOWING CDC GUIDELINES

Christ the King is following CDC guidelines regarding pandemic practices. Masks are recommended for those who are not fully vaccinated for COVID-19. Council has approved the use of the building by outside groups and for private gatherings once again.

### WORSHIP OPTIONS OFFERED AT CTK

For a trial period, the Sunday outdoor worship service can be viewed LIVE on the Big Screen in the sanctuary as an option for those who prefer a pew to a lawn chair/car seat. After Pastor Jeff communes the outdoor worshipers, he will go into the sanctuary to serve communion to those inside. Indoor worshipers may commune in their pews or kneel at the communion rail.

You may also livestream the service on the CtK Twinsburg channel of YouTube. Watch the *Weekend Messenger* and your email inbox for updates.



### CTK CARE TEAM HAS BEEN CREATED

On Wednesday, June 23rd, Pastor Jeff led a meeting to discuss the formation of a CARE Team at CtK. The intention of these teams is to stay in contact with CtK members and friends who are not able to attend worship in person. If you were unable to attend the meeting but have it in your heart to reach out to these people, please contact Pastor Jeff. Beginning July 28th there will be a monthly CARE team meeting at 7 PM on the last Wednesday of the month.



### CTK OFFICE CLOSURES IN JULY

### SUMMER WORSHIP TIME

In July & August, the Sunday outdoor worship service with Holy Communion is at 9:00 AM. This allows worship to wrap up before the day gets too hot. If you want to remain outdoors, consider bringing an umbrella to stay out of the direct sunlight.





### UNDIES SUNDAYS CONTINUE THROUGH AUGUST 15TH

After a one-year pandemic break, Outreach is again sponsoring CtK's annual Undies Sundays collection of underwear for clients of Haven of Rest in Akron. There is a bin in the Giving Center, and the collection will end Sunday, August 15th. There are two ground rules: 1. NO WHITE UNDIES. 2. COTTON UNDIES ONLY. 3. NO BIKINIS.

All sizes are needed for all ages & genders. Lynne Bailey will accept cash donations or checks made out to her to purchase undies.

### WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY MEETS

During the summer, the Tuesday Women's Bible study will meet once a month. On Tuesday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, all women are invited to meet from 10:00 AM to noon in room 105 and via Zoom for Session One, *Just Wisdom*, of *Just L.I.F.E. (Liberation Is For Everyone!)* by Angela T. Khabeb from the June issue of *Gather* magazine. Copies of the study will be distributed. Afterward the group will eat at a restaurant to be decided.

On Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, the group will meet at 10 AM to study Session Two, *Just Truth*, of *Just L.I.F.E. (Liberation Is For Everyone!)* from the July/August issue of *Gather* magazine. The group will again go out for lunch afterward.



### PASTOR JEFF LEADS WEDNESDAY STUDY

## Where are we headed?? Are we there yet??

Part of this work has been to develop an Interim Ministry Covenant that spells out the expectations of transitional/interim pastor & congregation during this in-between time.

And part of this covenant includes focus points - not the only things we will work on together, but the beginning points of focus for our work together!

*(Once the final draft of the covenant is reviewed and signed by the bishop after being approved by the synod council, and is signed by CtK Council President after being approved by CtK Council, and is signed by the transitional/interim pastor, we will share that document with you!)*

In the meantime, below are the 5 focus points we have discerned together:

1. Come to terms with CtK's history - acknowledge, celebrate, grieve, let go, and HEAL.
2. Review & update CtK's mission & vision.
3. Finances.
4. Have FUN together!
5. Develop a ministry site profile (MSP) through a pre-call committee, and call the next settled pastor through a call committee.

In light of these focus points, there are a few announcements / opportunities I'm excited to share with you!!!

### **The church building is OPEN!**

Continuing to follow CDC guidelines, there are no longer any mandatory restrictions for gathering in a church setting. For those un-vaccinated, masks and physical distancing are still recommended, but not required. For those who are vaccinated, masks and physical distancing are at your discretion, whatever is most comfortable for you.

*And as a Community of Love, we will all honor each and every individual's choices!*

*(Building use guidelines will return to pre-COVID guidelines, effective immediately.)*

### **Indoor Worship**

To mark the end of COVID restrictions, and to celebrate the re-opening of the church building, ***we will gather in the sanctuary for worship on Sunday, July 11 at 9:00am!!!***

We plan to livestream as we have been, and to transmit via the radio for those who wish to listen from the parking lot! (Communion will be brought outside to you.)

With the number of people and energy considerations, we will continue to celebrate one worship service on Sunday mornings, at 9:00 through the summer, outdoors in the parking lot, live-streamed and radio, with regular intervals of indoor worship, perhaps monthly, to be determined!

**BLOOD DRIVES SET THROUGH SEPTEMBER**

Because many businesses that used to host Red Cross blood drives are not fully open, the CtK Council has approved more frequent blood drives in the past year. CtK will host blood drives on these Tuesdays:

- July 6<sup>th</sup>, 12 – 6 pm
- July 20<sup>th</sup>, 10 am – 4 pm
- August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 12 – 6 pm
- August 17<sup>th</sup>, 10 am – 4 pm
- Sept. 7<sup>th</sup>, 12 – 6 pm;
- Sept. 21<sup>st</sup>, 10 am – 4 pm

Note that if the Red Cross is short-staffed, one or more of these drives may be canceled.

If you are a blood donor, go to redcrossblood.org to set up an appointment. Walk-ins have not been able to get appointments at recent drives. All donations are tested for COVID-19 antibodies. Donors who self-identify as African American will also have their blood tested for sickle cell markers.
