7:00 - 8:00 - Study group; those in attendance February 9th will decide the topic of the study.

SUNDAY WORSHIP GOES INDOORS! AGAIN!

After worshiping indoors for four weeks during Advent was halted by the omicron variant of COVID, as of Sunday, February 6th, weekly worship with Holy Communion will be back in the sanctuary on Sundays at 10:00 AM! The services will be livestreamed on the CtK Twinsburg channel of YouTube.com and broadcast on 90.1 FM for people who prefer to worship from their cars. The service can be heard in the narthex for those who want a more spacious indoor location. Indoor worshipers will be masked and distanced.



ANNUAL MEETING DECISIONS OUTLINED

Hardy CtK members braved a snowstorm on January 23rd to attend the Annual Meeting. Members were masked and distanced in the sanctuary (unlike in the clip art!), and proceedings were broadcast on 90.1 FM for at least one member who participated from the parking lot. The meeting included recognition of elected and appointed CtK leaders for 2021 and the installation of the 2022 Council: President Mike Coss, Vice President Katie Bach, Secretary Dusty Basmagy, and At-Large Members Bob Coleman, Kerry Dominick, & Glenn Fasnacht.



An updated 2022 Continuation & Improvement Plan (aka Budget) was presented. The initial plan, presented at the November congregational meeting, was adjusted to more accurately reflect ministry at CtK. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the Continuation and Improvement Plan for 2022 contingent on reevaluating the by-laws so Christ the King can correctly spend the endowment.

The Endowment Committee will recommend changes to by-laws, and members of CtK will have to approve these changes. Endowment members seeking input for by-law changes are Katie Bach, Rich Ciarniello, Lisa Doty, Denise Hall, & Jay Hartland. Come.



CHRIST THE KING COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES 12/13/21 7pm

Present in person: Pastor Jeff, Mike Coss, Bob Coleman, Karen Reid, Kerry Dominick (non voting), Dusty Basmagy (non voting) By Zoom: Glenn Fasnacht, Sally Morris, Katie Bach. Opening devotion by Karen. Agenda plus discussion of custodial service approved. It was decided that council members will monitor the cleaning done and that the treasurer be instructed to pay the cleaning service invoice just as any other service, such as the electric bill is paid without being signed off on. Minutes from Nov.2021 council meeting minutes approved.

Mike recognized outgoing council members- Karen and Sally- and welcomed incoming members Dusty and Kerry. Council briefly reviewed the "inactive members" list composed by Wendy Gibbons and decided we need to revamp our system of updating membership rolls. So this review was postponed for later consideration, realizing we do need to track "voting" members. Council would like Congregational Care's input about this process.

Pastor's report: Estimated 700 miles driven. Pastor said he has received feedback from congregational members that they support the direction of CTK ministry as evidenced by the November election. Then he outlined the synod's 2 pathways to church vitality- 1. the anchor model in which a larger congregation partners with a smaller congregation in which the smaller eventually grows to be independent or the smaller is adopted into the larger. 2.the parish model in which 3 or more churches are overseen by shared staff and one parish council. Currently there are 150 congregations in the NEOS and 50 have pastoral openings. Right now, in many churches, all energy is focused on keeping the doors open. When this stress is removed, churches can focus on ministry.

Concerning worship services, Pastor recommended CTK move to one worship service at 10am after Christmas. We can plan for a combination of indoor and outdoor services, maybe even a midweek service, maybe with a meal. Then, Pastor discussed a revision of CTK's intentional interim covenant with him for 2022 which would involve fewer hours worked and revised goals. He again suggested using the Congregational Systems Team services by contacting Pastor Henderson to study how CTK functions. This process could occur at the same time as the revision of CTK financial practices and the development of the call committee. Council approved two staff position descriptions- director of music, office administrator- and compensation in 2022.

Concerning revisions to the Continuation and Improvement Plan, Mike Coss and Pastor propose 1.Funding all ministries except property from endowment funds 10K, 2.PPE loan to cover call process 10K, 3.Parking lot repair cost from endowment 15K. 4.Revise endowment bylaws.5.Reduced pastoral hours to 75% of full time. In addition, Pastor expressed dissatisfaction with the health insurance selected for him. The revised Plan will be presented for vote at the congregational meeting on Jan. 23. Next council meeting scheduled for 1/10/22. Meeting adjourned 11pm.

CTK COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES FROM 12/19/21 at 9:30am:

Pastor Jeff, Mike Coss, Katie Bach, Bob Coleman, Karen Reid, Sally Morris, Glenn Fasnacht, Kerry Dominick, Dusty Basmagy were all present. A motion was made by council president Mike Coss as follows "As of January 1, 2022, CTK Council will assume the duties held by the CTK Church Treasurer and Financial Secretary. In addition CTK Council will assume the duties of overseeing the investment held by Ameriprise Advisors for the various CTK Church Endowment Funds. CTK Council will evaluate all aspects of CTK finances to determine what changes will be beneficial for the future financial security of CTK Church.These will include sound financial practices/accounting methods, relationships with current bank/ investment institutions, and finding/hiring an established accounting firm to assume the duties currently held by Treasurer and Financial Secretary." End of motion. Kerry suggested we emphasize kindness and appreciation for Mike P and Sandy's service. A concern was raised about bill and staff payments and maintaining the good status of church finances. Bills come thru the office administrator and during the interim, if necessary, Council President Mike Coss is a signatory on the Huntington account and can sign checks to make payments. Pastor noted that steps have already been taken to possibly use QuickBooks for church finances and a bookkeeper to keep the books. Glenn seconded Mike C's motion. Five council members voted to approve Mike C's motion, with 2 members abstaining, and Kerry and Dusty not voting since they are not eligible until 2022.
