CTK'S RETURN TO OUTDOOR WORSHIP MOVES TO JUNE 5TH

Spring has arrived, and longer days and warmer weather are developing! This means it's time to get back outside!

Many months ago we planned to transition back outside for our Sunday morning One Worship Experience after Easter. **We will transition outdoors with a special worship experience on Pentecost Sunday, June 5th!** (The date to begin to worship outside was changed because of staffing concerns.)

A special, safe, sacred sanctuary space will be created outside, to be used until the change of seasons calls us to return inside!

This will not be a drive-in worship experience, from inside or right next to our vehicles. We will gather together in a defined space, much like we do inside! Shade/shelter will be set up. Folding chairs will be provided, and space will be available for you to bring and sit in your own chair. An altar will be set up. All musicians and worship leaders will be outside. Live streaming and broadcasting on 90.1 FM will continue.

Our hope is to take the best of our current, beautiful indoor worship experience, and continue it outside, integrating it with the best of what the outside worship experience offers! God's Loving presence will surely be with us, and so it promises to be a beautiful experience! - *Pastor Jeff*



OUTDOOR WORSHIP VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

When CtK returns to outdoor worship on June 5th, set-up teams will be needed to prepare the worship space before the 10:00 AM service. Considerable equipment must be moved outdoors, and helping move supplies provides an opportunity for everyone to take an active role in weekly services. The more people who pitch in, the faster the process will go. Watch the *Weekend Messenger* or talk to Pastor Jeff or a Council member for more information. Volunteers are asked to arrive around 9:00 AM so that everything will be in place by 9:30 AM.

Equipment will have to be taken indoors after worship, but generally many people are willing to help put everything away.

ORDER YOUR PENTECOST GERANIUMS!

CtK will celebrate Pentecost on June 5th with red geraniums in the worship space. The sign-up sheet for the plants will be on the bulletin board through Sunday, May 22nd. A 4-inch pot costs \$1.25, and CtK will get the flowers from Pochedleys' Greenhouse in Hiram, the same source of flowers as in recent years.



You may take the flowers home to plant or donate them to be planted in CtK gardens by CtK gardener Lisa Doty, Please note your plans on the sign-up sheet. Make payment to CtK through your giving envelope, designating *Geraniums*.

Contact Wendy in the office if you have a large enough vehicle to pick up the flowers before June 5th. (Last year CtK had 122 plants, requiring a full-sized pickup truck to move them!)

Stay after worship that day for a special reception honoring these youth. (Did somebody say "ice cream!"?)


GRADUATION RECOGNITION BEING PLANNED

APPROVED MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING ON MARCH 14TH 2022

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Those present were Pastor Jeff Goggins, Katie Bach, Mike Coss, Bob Coleman, Kerry Dominick and Dusty Basmagy. Karen Reid attended on behalf of the [Congregational]Systems Team. Glenn Fasnacht was not present, but telephoned into the meeting around 7 p.m.

Dusty began the meeting with an opening devotion. The agenda for the meeting was approved. The minutes from the council meeting on February 18th 2022 were approved. Pastor's report was printed and passed out to those in attendance. He addressed the following issues; transition, the Budget Ease proposal and mask guidelines.



The new mask guideline was briefly discussed. It was decided that as of March 14th 2022 masks will be optional at Christ the King. Christ the King will continue to follow both CDC guidelines and Summit County Board of Health recommendations.

Karen Reid passed out a report and spoke about the [Congregational] Systems Team. A pre-printed insert will go into the Sunday bulletin in the near future to further explain the purpose of the CST. In the near future Pastor Rob Henderson and his staff will interview various members of the congregation about Christ The King's goals and purposes.

The Budget Ease proposal was discussed. It was noted that everything on the books has been reconciled. However, Budget Ease is not a long-term solution. A motion was made by Glenn Fasnacht and seconded by Bob Coleman that Christ the King continue to use Budget Ease for monthly accounting until a final proposal is accepted. The motion carried unanimously.

The next meeting was set for April the 4th 2022 at 6:00 p.m. Items on the agenda will include nine areas of focus and the upcoming Synod Assembly on May 13th and 14th 2022. The meeting adjourned about 9:15 p.m.

Written responses may also be submitted to the Congregational Systems Team members on the evening of the interview process. An "Interview and Action Report" will be presented to the church council and congregation within approximately six to eight weeks following the interviews.
