### CONGREGATIONAL MEETING SET FOR AUGUST 14

On Sunday, August 14th, there will be a congregational meeting in the sanctuary at 10:00 AM - right after worship. The congregation will vote on proposed changes to the By-Laws of the CtK Constitution. The purpose of the change is to create the CtK Mission Fund to allow use of CtK's endowment funds to help both organizations and individuals in the community and to help Christ the King pay its bills. The proposed changes were shared at a July 17th informational meeting.

Please contact Wendy in the office if you can provide a couple dozen cookies or other finger treats for the August 11th meeting.

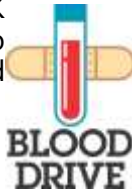


### TWINS DAYS IS AUGUST 6TH & 7TH

## MINUTES FOR CHRIST THE KING COUNCIL MEETING ON JUNE 13TH 2022

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. Those present were Pastor Jeff Goggins, Mike Coss, Katie Bach and Dusty Basmagy. Bob Coleman, Kerry Dominick and Glenn Fasnacht did not attend. Also in attendance was Brian McCarty from Thrivent Financial services.

The minutes from the May 9th 2022 council meeting were approved as was the agenda for tonight. No other motions were made at this meeting.

The first hour of the meeting was used to sign various documents with Thrivent Financial Services to transfer the endowment fund, currently invested with Ameriprise to Thrivent Financial Services. Brian agreed to return to Christ the King on Sunday August 7th to introduce himself to the congregation and speak about Thrivent Financial Services. This meeting will take place after church around 11:00 a.m.

Next, as per the church bylaws (c 17.03) changes to the bylaws were discussed concerning the current endowment fund. If approved, it will now be known as Christ the King Mission Fund and Ministry. A first draft of the new document was submitted and the wording was discussed. The congregation will be notified within 30 days of these changes by email and a copy will be posted on the bulletin board by July 12th 2022. A congregational meeting to discuss the changes will be held on Sunday July 17th 2022, immediately after church. A final congregational meeting will be held on August 14th 2022 to vote on these changes. This final congregational meeting will be one week after Thrivent presentation.

Finally, Pastor Jeff shared what happened at the Cuyahoga Valley Area Summit. The summit was held at Christ the King on Sunday June 12th 2022. Five people from three other local ELCA churches attended, along with five from Christ the King. Three

synod staff people also attended. Two possible pathways were presented. Pastor Jeff summarized his preference as follows: There are two other congregations in geographic proximity to Christ the King that are currently without a settled pastor. They are Church of the Master in Bedford Heights and Rejoice in Hudson. A potential pathway forward is to enter into conversation with these two congregations, and explore partnering together in a parish model with a pastoral leadership team.

Each congregation would continue to exist where and as it is, each having its own council with the same responsibilities as they have currently. The primary difference would be the establishment of a Parish Council that would include representatives from each congregation and the pastoral leadership team. This council would be responsible for guiding the development and growth of the overall mission and vision of the Parish.

The next Christ the King council meeting is scheduled for July 11th 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 9:30 p.m.

MINUTES FOR MAY 9<sup>TH</sup>, 2022 COUNCIL MEETING

The meeting began at 6:05 p.m. Those in attendance were Pastor Jeff Goggins, president Mike Coss, Bob Coleman and Dusty Basmagy. Kerry Dominick arrived at 6:30 p.m. and Glenn Fasnacht attended by cell phone. Katie Bach was absent. Brian McCarty from Thrivent Financial Services also attended.

The agenda for the evenings meeting was approved unanimously.

The minutes from the April Christ the King council meeting were approved unanimously.

President Mike announced that there was approximately \$400,000 in liquid cash currently available in the Christ the King endowment fund. He speculated that this amount could help to support the church over the next three to five years.

Next, Brian gave a presentation about Thrivents management services and proposal. He analyzed Christ The King's risk tolerance and the goals of the church. Currently, Christ the King is invested in a moderate fund, which is 60% in stocks 40% in bonds along with some cash. He recommended Thrivents "Select Model." it is also a moderate investment and is actively managed with an annual fee. He explained how the money would be transferred. He said the costs would be lower and based on past performer is slightly better. Our current annual fee is 1.15%, Thrivent would charge .85%. Christ The King's current net expense is .85%, Thrivent would be at .44%. Glenn made a motion to transfer all existing Christ the King funds currently held at Ameriprise to Thrivent. The motion was seconded by Kerry and passed unanimously.

It was then decided to have two congregational meetings concerning these decisions. The first will be on July 10th 2022 after worship. It will be an informational meeting with a presentation and a meet and greet with Brian and or Stephanie McCarthy from Thrivent. The new recommend changes/amendments to the bylaws concerning the endowment would also be presented at this meeting. A second special called meeting on July 17th 2022 would be held after worship for a congregational vote on the by law changes.

The new recommendations for the endowment are; up to 4% of the endowment for Christ The King's mission work in the community on an annual basis and up to 4% of the endowment to support Christ The King's ongoing mission. A rough draft will be worked on by Pastor Jeff and Mike.

Bob made a motion that all endowment requests and grants for spring of 2022 should be approved. It was seconded by Dusty and passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Bob to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. it was seconded by many and approved unanimously.
