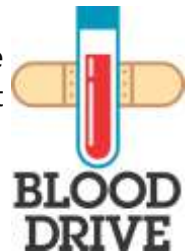

**AGENDA**

Chris Driver asked everyone for revision to the proposed agenda that was emailed in advance of the meeting. John Kaufman made the motion to approve the agenda as amended to reflect visit from Deacon Erin Bodenstab instead of Nathan Kraus for April 26, and a second was provided by Brian Harnak. All approved.

**MINUTES**

The minutes from the previous meeting were emailed in advance of the meeting. Two name-spelling corrections were made. Hearing no other changes or additions, Denise Tiearney made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected, with a second by Karen Reid. All voted in favor of accepting the minutes.

**MINISTRY REPORTS**

**Altar Guild Ministry** (Council rep - Denise) Gluten free wafers have been breaking up. Altar Guild will begin making gluten-free bread.

**Council** – Council approved Annual Congregational Meeting minutes, with Karen Reid moving and John seconding. All voted in favor.

**Finance Ministry** (Council rep - Chris Driver) Operating fund was above expenses by \$6,200. Insurance policy has been successfully renewed. Increase for premiums were below budgeted amounts.

**Property Ministry** (Council rep - Bob Coleman) A one-year mowing contract quote was approved by email.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Discussion of Interim Pastor Possibility** – Pastor Mitch Philips (NEOS) has been in touch with Council about the availability as an interim pastor that might be shared with another church. Chris reviewed the potential budgetary requirements for an interim pastor split with another church: salary, benefits, mileage, etc. Council also discussed the differences in financial commitments for a part-time interim pastor versus supply pastors, the scarcity of full-time pastors, and the goal of growing the church. Council will tell Pastor Mitch that CtK would be interested in meeting with the potential part-time interim pastor.
