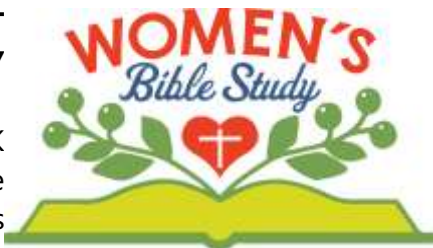
**MEN HAVE BREAKFAST TOGETHER MONTHLY**

AGENDA

A change was made to agenda to add Pastor Phil's housing allowance resolution. Brian Harnak made the motion to approve the agenda as amended, and a second was provided by Chris Driver. All approved.

MINUTES

Council meeting minutes of March 11th, 2026, (2) the monthly Council meeting of April 8th, and (3) the Special Meeting of April 23rd, 2026 regarding Pastor Phil Kunder's contract were presented. Brian made a motion to accept the March 11th meeting minutes, the April 8th meeting minutes, and the April 23rd Special Council meeting minutes, with a second by Denise. All voted in favor of accepting the minutes for all three meetings.

MINISTRY REPORTS

Council – Pastor Phil's housing allowance was approved by Council. A Resolution was read by Bob Coleman for the exclusion of a certain amount of his salary to be designated as Pastor Phil's Housing allowance in the amount of \$13,500. Brian made the Motion to approve, Chris seconded. All were in favor.

Finance Ministry (Council rep - Chris Driver) - Offerings in the first quarter were about \$38,500. Total expenses were about \$34,600. Spending will be up approximately \$2,500 with the addition of Pastor Phil's salary and fringes. Power Church Plus software moved to the back office room so allow for space to work. In the process of learning how to run different reports on the software.

Generosity Discretionary Funds (Council rep - Bob) – Chris did a great job handling requests from individuals seeking help while Bob was out of town. Gift cards distributed to 7 individuals, 10 times total so far this year, in a total amount of \$600. List is updated regularly.

Mission Fund (Council rep - Karen Reid) Discussion of Thrivent's Socially Conscious Fund. Bob to reach out to Thrivent Rep Brian and/or Stephanie to get a date when they could come out to discuss, possibly on a Sunday after services. Checks for grants out of the mission fund were written by Mike Pereksta this year.

Property Ministry (Council rep - Bob Coleman)

Tina Coleman's family requested use of old coffee maker for their reunion, which was approved by universal acclamation.

Project to scrape, prime, paint, repair as needed, the white trim at CtK was discussed. Brian moved to approve an amount not to exceed \$8,000 to hire a contractor to perform said project at CtK. Denise seconded the motion. Said motion was approved by all members.

NEW BUSINESS

Pastor Phil's Report – Pastor Phil discussed his schedule for the upcoming weeks. Hymns to be selected by the Pastor for the Sundays that he presides. Kevin would select the other dates. Gluten free communion offerings protocol should use individually wrapped wafers, for concern about severe allergies. Pastor Phil to prepare liturgy in the bulletin for those dates he presides. He attended various ministry meetings.

UPDATE FOR JUNE 2026**

For donations of clothing placed in CtK's Used Clothing Shed in June, CtK received \$275 from St. Pauly Textile, who



maintains the shed. CtK has received \$1,584 so far in 2026 and \$21,394 since the shed was installed in 2014.

A representative of St. Pauly spent one of the hottest days of this summer repairing some rotted wood trim on the shed. CtK has to register the shed with the City of Twinsburg annually, and St. Pauly pays the registration fee. Thanks to Bob Coleman for working to get all the paperwork submitted for 2026, including re-applying for a lapsed State of Ohio form.

Thanks to Karen Reid for taking time to manage the contents of the shed when too much time elapses between clothing pick-ups by St. Pauly!
